

Improper Dealings Caveat (Removal) ID Check - Personal Information Collection Notice

The Western Australian Land Information Authority, trading as Landgate, collects personal information where required by law or to provide services to you. Collecting personal information

Your personal information is being collected by Landgate.

We collect your personal information to enable us to process your lodgment documents presented at our counter.

Authority to collect personal information

Your personal information is collected as part of performing our registration and titling functions under the *Transfer of Land Act 1893*.

Choosing not to provide personal information

If you choose not to provide some or all of the requested personal information, Landgate will not be able to complete your request to remove the Improper Dealings Caveat under the requirements outlined in the *Transfer of Land Act 1893*.

Disclosing personal information

Your personal information will not be disclosed outside of Landgate.
