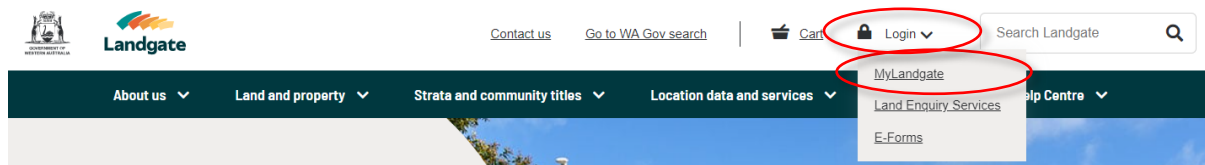

# Log into MyLandgate

When you have registered for a Landgate Login and joined a billing account, you will have access to MyLandgate. MyLandgate is a portal which allows access to specialised applications for industry professionals.

## Step 1 – navigate to Landgate’s login page

To start the log in process, visit the Landgate website [www.landgate.wa.gov.au](http://www.landgate.wa.gov.au) and click onto the MyLandgate login button at the top right.



This will load the login screen. From here you can:

- log in with your Landgate Login that you have already set up
- reset your password
