

INSTRUCTIONS

1. If insufficient space in any section, additional sheet Form B1, should be used with appropriate headings. The boxed sections should only contain the words "see page....."
2. Additional sheets must be numbered consecutively. They must be bound to this document by staples along the left margin prior to execution by the parties.
3. No alteration should be made by erasure or use of correction fluid. The words rejected should be scored through and those substituted typed or written above them, the alteration being initialled by the person/s signing this document.
4. Landgate may need to contact you in respect of your application. Please ensure that your best available contact details are provided in the "Lodged by" panel of this form, using the check boxes to indicate your preferred contact method. Landgate will store all applications securely and undertakes not to divulge the personal contact details shown on this form to any other party.
5. The Applicant/s will be notified by their preferred contact method (see instruction 4) of the outcome of their application.
6. Where property is held in more than one name Joint Applications will be accepted where applicants are immediate family only i.e. spouse and/or child/ren. The primary applicant (the person who is at greatest risk) should include details of any such relationship in their Statutory Declaration. Joint owners, other than immediate family, must make separate applications.
7. If a single Statutory Declaration is being made by two or more persons, the signatures of each applicant must be to be independently witnessed i.e. the witness must sign separately under each of the applicants signatures.
8. Landgate does not accept liability for information revealed on records that were not included in your application. It is important to be sure that you have included all relevant records.

NOTES

1. **DESCRIPTION OF LAND AND/OR PROPERTY STREET ADDRESS**
Property street address may be used as a sole reference or in conjunction with the details shown on a copy of the title and will consist of Unit, Street Number, Street Name and Suburb within Western Australia. While the Lot and Diagram/Plan/Deposited Plan/Strata/Survey-Strata Plan number or Location name and number are not required, if you can provide them your application can be processed more quickly. A copy of your Certificate of Title containing all of the above information can be purchased at Landgate
2. **POWER OF ATTORNEY DOCUMENT**
Insert the Landgate Power of Attorney document reference number where the applicant is either shown as the donor or donee. For example G123456.
3. **APPLICANT**
Where applicable, state full name of the person/s applying to have their name suppressed. Where there is only one applicant, then that applicant must be shown on all of the properties or Power of Attorney documents listed in the Application. Any Joint Applicant's name must be shown on at least one of the properties or Power of Attorney documents listed in the Application. Joint applicants see instruction 6 above.
4. Only names shown on Landgate's databases which exactly match the names in the application will be suppressed. When there is a discrepancy Landgate may contact the applicant to clarify the discrepancy.
5. **REASON FOR APPLICATION**
This panel has been completed for you and needs no further amendment. Landgate will restrict access to its data for all property/ies and/or any Power of Attorney document shown in this document held in the name of the Applicant.
